Researchers now have unlocked the genome of the Arabica species and traced its origins to a natural mating between two other coffee species an estimated 610,000 to one million years ago in the forests of Ethiopia. That makes this species older than our own species Homo sapiens, which arose in Africa about 300,000 years ago.

#### Did you know?

Ethiopia has unveiled three national strategies that would contribute to the country's endeavors in food transformation systems. The strategies consist of National Food Safety and Quality Strategy for Primary Agricultural Produce, National Nutrition Sensitive Agrifood Systems Strategy and Post-Harvest Management Strategy.

#### Did you know?

Ethiopia obtained 617 million USD from exported products during the last 8 months of the current fiscal year.

#### Did you know?

Safaricom Telecommunications Ethiopia has ambitious plans to triple its telecom tower network over the coming three years, set to invest more than USD 1.5 billion to extend its coverage across the country despite the obstacles posed by security concerns.

#### Did you know?

Lawmakers in Washington are pushing a bill that would see a 16-year extension of a US preferential trade regime with Sub-Saharan Africa but there have been no official indications that Ethiopia will be reinstated to the African Growth and Opportunity Act (AGOA).

#### European Council restricts visa provision to Ethiopia

As indicated on the press release of the council of the EU <a href="here">here</a>, the Council has decided to temporarily suspend certain elements of the EU law that regulates the issuing of visas to Ethiopian nationals. In particular, it will no longer be possible for member states:

- to waive requirements with regard to the evidence to be submitted by Ethiopian visa applicants
- > to issue multiple entry visas
- to waive the visa fee for holders of diplomatic and service passports

Furthermore, the standard visa-processing period now becomes 45 calendar days instead of 15 days.

#### Nat'l Sustainable Energy Development Strategy Launched

The Ministry of Water and Energy has launched a National Sustainable Development Strategy of Ethiopia (N-SEDS) 2024-2030 today in Addis Ababa to address the challenges in the sector. The overarching goal of the strategy is to guide actions for a sustainable and inclusive energy future in Ethiopia.

## United Kingdom to suspend tariffs on fresh-cut flower imports



In an official press statement released, the government of the UK announced that it has temporarily removed export tariffs for cut flowers, with the aim of making trade with the UK easier and cheaper for growers in East Africa – including Ethiopia – and beyond. Ethiopia is said to be the second largest cut flower producer in Africa – behind Kenya, making up 23% of Sub-Saharan African exports. #### IMF ends Ethiopia visit, deal not yet secured

The International Monetary Fund concluded its visit to Ethiopia to discuss a request for IMF support on Tuesday without reaching an agreement, leaving the East African nation short of a commitment it made with its official international creditors.

"The team made substantial progress towards establishing how the IMF could support the authorities' economic program, and discussions will continue later this month in Washington", the IMF said. But the Paris Club of developed creditor nations, which does not include China, said last year that an agreement to suspend Ethiopia's debt payments through 2025 could be voided if the country did not secure an IMF loan. ## New legislation to shift gov't project compensation payments to regional admins

Legislation tabled to Parliament proposes to relieve the federal government from its duty to pay compensation to landowners in regional states whose properties are appropriated for development projects. The amendment to the 'Expropriation of landholdings for public purpose, payment of compensation and resettlement' proclamation seeks to make regional administrations wholly responsible for compensation payments, including for displacement and moral compensation, even if the project in question is federally-run.

## Ethiopian Securities Exchange (ESX) unveils stringent listing requirements

Companies looking for a listing on the main board of the upcoming Ethiopian Securities Exchange (ESX) are required to hold at least half a billion birr in capital, according to a newly-published rulebook. The 259-page document stipulates that companies must have been in operation for a minimum of three years prior to listing.
