PAPER PRESENTATION

Short papers: Writing in Spanish, Portuguese or English, with a maximum of 5 pages (A-4), margins of 2.5 cm, single line spacing and Times New Roman 12-point font. It will consist of Title, Authors, Institution, Postal Address, Fax and E-mail, Abstract of no more than 250 words, four (4) keywords, Brief introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion with a maximum of two (2) figures or two (2) tables. There can be included a total of five (5) bibliographic references. Do not use notes at the bottom of the page. The papers will be sent in electronic format, Microsoft Office, identified with the name of the author and the file.

Paper presented by producers: Writing in Spanish, Portuguese or English, with a maximum of 3 pages (A-4), margins of 2.5 cm, single line spacing and Times New Roman 12-point type. It will consist of Title, Authors, Institution, Postal Address, Fax and E-mail, Abstract and information on how the work was developed, main results and conclusions

Lectures: The lectures will be requested by the Scientific Committee and those interested in contributing with a specific topic, can make the application for its evaluation. Writing in Spanish, Portuguese or English, with a maximum of 10 pages (A-4), margins of 2.5 cm, single line spacing and Times New Roman 12 points type. It will consist of Title, Authors, Institution, Postal Address, Fax and E-mail, Abstract of no more than 250 words, five (5) keywords, Introduction, Development, Conclusions and References. Tables and figures needed.

Presentation: oral or on posters, which will be previously informed to the authors.

Videos of 15 minutes maximum duration after consultation with the Scientific Committee.
